Course The 5 mile race follows an out and back course between the bends of the Shenandoah River. The course is not difficult, but is somewhat rolling. **Due to insurance concerns**, please, no dogs, baby strollers, and/or headphones.

Awards 5 miler awards will be given to the top three men and women overall, to the top male and female masters runners (40 & over), and to the top three male and female runners in the following age groups: 18 and under, 19-29, 30-39, 40-49, 50-59, 60 and over.

Entry Fees 5 mile entry fees are \$19.00 for members of the Shenandoah Valley Runners and \$20.00 for non-members if you pre-register by May 28th. **All runners who register by May 28th will receive a race shirt.** From May 29th until the day of the race the fee is also \$19.00 for members and \$20.00 for non-members, <u>but no t-shirts will be available</u>.
